RE: UPDATE ON THE MULTIPLE REGISTRATIONS OF LEARNERS ON MULTIPLE SKILL PROGRAMMES

Dear Valued Stakeholder,

The Mining Qualifications Authority (MQA) remains committed to its mandate of supporting skills development within the Mining and Minerals sector through the effective registration of learners in various MQA-accredited programmes.

Purpose:

The sector requested that the MQA revise the rule to allow learners to register for multiple skills programme in the same financial year.

The MQA is pleased to inform all stakeholders that system adjustments have been made, and the system is now live for use. The employers can now proceed with registering learners on multiple skills programmes without any further interruptions.

Employers should ensure that learners captured on the system are registered within six months from the date of capture. Assessments of registered learners must be uploaded and declared competent within six months from the date of registration, failure to comply will result in both captured and registered learners being removed/deleted from the system.

The MQA values the dedication and partnership of our stakeholders in advancing skills development within our sector. We trust that these changes will enable the sector to successfully implement skills programmes.
